



April 2024 National/Global Mission- Hygiene Kits for Church World Service (CWS)-continues until Tuesday, April 30, 2024. Let's show our support of individuals and families who are dealing with natural disasters, violence, and extreme poverty throughout our country and the world by donating hygiene kits to Church World Service. Please consider supporting this

very worthwhile cause by either providing all the required items for one or two complete hygiene kit(s) (approximate value of each kit = \$15.00) or donating one or two specific required items so we can use them in extra hygiene kits. Each hygiene kit (packed in a 1-gallon Ziploc bag) must contain the following: 1 hand towel (measuring approx. 15" x 28" to 16" x 32"- no fingertip, bath, dish or microfiber towels); 1 washcloth; 1 wide-tooth comb (must be sturdy with at least 6" of wide teeth; removed from the package); 1 fingernail or toenail clipper (removed from the package- either is acceptable); 1 bath-size bar of soap (in the original package); 1 toothbrush (in the original package); and 10 standard size Band-Aids. Mission offerings will be used to purchase more items to complete hygiene kits and/or help to pay the processing fee of \$2.00 per kit.
