Q: What is Camp Compassion?

A: Camp Compassion is 2 FREE evenings of VBS-style activities for kids and families. We know your schedules are hectic so instead of setting aside a week of evenings for VBS, we are offering two single nights of programming. They will be different but not reliant on each other. So you can attend both nights or one night.

Q: When is Camp Compassion?

A: July 8th and August 5th, from 6pm to 8pm.

Q: Where is Camp Compassion?

A: We will be gathering at Longswamp United Church of Christ at 200 Clay Rd in Mertztown in the pavilion area behind the church.

Q: Who can come to Camp Compassion?

A: Everyone is welcome! Camp Compassion is geared toward being attending *WITH* your family. However, if your child is going into first grade they are able to attend the program without a parent/guardian present.

Q: What will we do at Camp Compassion?

A: Each evening will focus on a different story of Jesus caring for someone in-need. Our goal will be learning how we can also be compassionate within our communities and to the world around us. We'll begin each evening with a light dinner around the campfire, including the Bible story and songs. Then the kids will be able to head off to different stations like crafts, games, nature time, and more. At this time, parents will be able to connect with other parents while the kids enjoy the nearby stations. We'll close the evening around the campfire again!

Q: What should my child wear and bring?

A: We suggest close-toed shoes and clothes you don't mind getting dirty. Bringing a water bottle with your name on it is a good idea too.
